1.0 lb Black Roasted
1.0 lb Flaked Wheat
1.0 lb Flaked Oats

1.0 lb Turbinado Sugar
1.5 oz Rosemary
1.0 oz Corriander

1.0 oz Cascades
1.0 oz Kent Goldings
1.0 oz Yakima
1.0 oz Saaz
