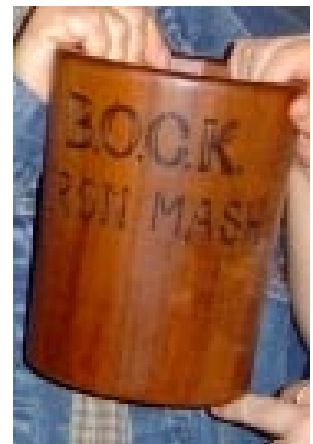
The plan:
